<p>1 person in the U.S. gets cancer caused by HPV every ___ minutes. <i>20 minutes</i></p>	<p>A group of viruses that commonly affects both boys and girls <i>Human Papillomavirus (HPV)</i></p>	<p>A serious bacterial infection that may result in inflammation of the lining of the brain and spinal cord <i>Meningococcal disease</i></p>
<p>This person invented the world's first vaccine. <i>Edward Jenner</i></p>	<p>Adolescent vaccines (HPV, Tdap, Meningococcal) are recommended at this age <i>11-12 years</i></p>	<p>Additional vaccines may be needed for this activity <i>Travel</i></p>
<p>HPV infections can lead to this <i>Cancer: cervical, penile, anal, oropharyngeal</i></p>	<p>This vaccine is a 2-dose series, if started before age 15 <i>HPV vaccine</i></p>	<p>Name of the statewide adolescent immunization contest <i>Protect Me With 3+</i></p>
<p>This is the only disease that has been completely eradicated by a vaccine so far. <i>Smallpox</i></p>	<p>HPV infections are most common at this age range <i>Teens and early 20s</i></p>	<p>Vaccines stimulate this to keep you healthy <i>Immune system</i></p>
